

Tender Change Note (TCN-1)

Tender No. BBUNL/COML/CIV-RAUB/2010/4 dated 14.01.2010

With reference to the above tender, the following paragraphs/clauses as appearing in the Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) are now amended and these paragraph/paragraphs shall now be read as under;

Sub: Invitation of tender for survey, investigation, design, construction, testing & commissioning of new steel latticed bridge of 900 mm diameter new rising main, on both sides of Naini Rail cum Road bridge on Yamuna river on existing piers of the bridge in Allahabad city with a view to sign a pre-bid agreement for participation in the similar tender invited by Ganga Pollution Control Unit of UP Jal Nigam, Allahabad.

1.0 With a view to enter into pre-bid tie-up agreement with a suitable company/firm for participation in similar tender, sealed tenders under two part bid system (Techno-Commercial bid & Price bid) are invited from resourceful, experienced and reputed engineering companies/firms (vendors), meeting the qualification criteria as mentioned below for carrying out construction work in Allahabad city as mentioned below;

2.0 SALIENT TERMS & CONDITIONS:

2.1 Complete set of tender documents can be obtained from the office of **BHARAT BHARI UDYOG NIGAM LIMITED (BBUNL)** at the above address, during the period for sale on all

working days between 10.00 hours to 17:30 hours against the payment of Rs. 20,000/- (Rs. twenty thousand only) through Demand Draft/Pay Order of any Nationalized Bank payable at Kolkata and issued in favour of **BHARAT BHARI UDYOG NIGAM LIMITED**.

- 2.2 A two-envelope bidding procedure shall be adopted. Bidders are to submit simultaneously two sealed envelopes, one containing the Technical Proposal and the other containing the price proposal.
- 2.3 Envelope containing the Technical Proposal shall be opened immediately thereafter in the presence of bidders/or their representatives who choose to attend. The substantially responsive technical proposals may be discussed with the bidders and bidders may be requested to adjust their proposals to reflect changes and amendments requested by the BBUNL. The bidder shall further be requested to submit supplementary price proposal which contain the changes in price resulting from discussed changes in their technical proposals only.
- 2.4 Envelope containing the Price Proposal and Supplementary Price Proposals, if any, shall have +ve (positive) variation in prices based on technical clarification, and the same shall be opened in the presence of bidder's/or their representatives who choose to attend. The time and date of opening the Price Proposal shall be intimated, after the evaluation of the technical proposals.
- 2.5 Technical Eligibility Criteria: The vendor/ bidder shall be a registered contractor in appropriate category under any Govt./Semi Govt. Organization. The bidder must have successfully completed construction of steel lattice bridge/ steel truss bridge during the last 10 (ten) years ending on 31.01.2010. The bidding firm/ company should meet the following eligibility criteria.
- (i) Should have successfully completed three similar works as mentioned above each atleast Rs. 6.40 Cr.
- OR
- (ii) Should have successfully completed two similar works as mentioned below each atleast Rs. 8.00 Cr.
- OR
- (iii) Should have successfully completed one similar work as mentioned above atleast Rs.12.80 Cr.
- 2.6 Financial Eligibility Criteria:
- (a) Turnover: The average annual turnover should be at least Rs. 4.80 Cr. during the last 3 years ending 31.03.2009 and Rs 8.00 Cr. in any financial year.
- (b) Profit & Loss: The firm should not have incurred any loss in more than two years during the last 5 years. The firm should have a positive Net Worth.
- (c) Solvency Certificate: The firm should have solvency of the amount equal to Rs. 6.40 Cr.
- (d) Performance Reports: The firm/bidder should have successfully executed above works as mentioned in Para 2.5 above during last 10 (ten) years ending 31.01.2010 and shall submit certification/proof from the user/end user in support of execution of similar work as stated above. The firm/bidder shall substantiate the

entire above requirement with proof, letters from clients, experience and performance certificates, giving the name of work and quantity of materials used in this project.

(e) The pre-qualification bidders who qualify in the bid shall be required to participate in the tendering process.

In case the bidder, who qualifies in the technical bid, does not participate in tendering process, then their earnest money deposited with P/Q bid shall be forfeited.

- 2.7 The tender documents can be obtained from BBUNL Office, Kolkata by sending authorized representative, upon payment of tender cost as mentioned at Para 2.1.
- 2.8 The Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) amounting Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees ten lakh) must be enclosed with the tender in the shape of DD/Pay Order drawn in favour of **BHARAT BHARI UDYOG NIGAM LIMITED**, payable at Kolkata. Earnest Money, in the form of Bank Guarantee from a Nationalized Bank as per format enclosed at Annexure-2, may also be submitted alongwith your offer. EMD should remain valid for 120 days from the date of opening of tender. Tender not accompanied with full EMD shall be rejected.
- 2.9 The tenderers may submit the duly completed documents on or before specified date up to 17:00 hrs in BBUNL office as mentioned above.
- 2.10 Firms/bidder are advised to visit the site on any working day for any clarification before quoting the rates after giving prior information to this office.
- 2.11 BBUNL reserves the right to:
 - 2.11.1 Accept or reject any bid received at its discretion without assigning any reasons whatsoever.
 - 2.11.2 Increase/decrease/alter the job description/scope of work with corresponding change in the value of contract.
 - 2.11.3 Postpone or extend the above mentioned date, split and distribute the work among more than one bidder without assigning any reason whatsoever.
 - 2.11.4 May ask for further qualification during techno commercial scrutiny of bids received.
 - 2.11.5 BBUNL shall not be responsible for any delay, loss, damage for bids sent by post.
 - 2.11.6 BBUNL shall not be liable for any expenses incurred by bidder in preparation of bid irrespective of whether it is accepted or not.
 - 2.11.7 Canvassing i.e. soliciting favour, seeking advantage etc. in any form is strictly prohibited and any bidder found to have engaged in canvassing shall be liable to have his bid rejected summarily.
 - 2.11.8 If the bidder deliberately gives any wrong information in his tender to create in circumstances for the acceptance to his bid, BBUNL reserves the right to reject such application.
 - 2.11.9 The job may be distributed to more than one bidder at the discretion of BBUNL.
 - 2.11.10 To offer lowest rate to other bidders with a view to expedite execution of the work as per requirement.

2.12 All amendments/Tender Change Notice (TCN) will be notified in our website at www.bbunl.com only.

Besides above, following new clauses are being incorporated in the Notice Inviting Tender (NIT);

3.0 All the bidders shall have to give undertaking to accept all the contractual terms & conditions of the tender for similar work invited by UP Jal Nigam vide ref. no. 417/610/77 dated 11.02.2010, both techno-commercial and financial and also all the terms & conditions as appearing in this tender, NIT, on back-to-back basis.

4.0 Mobilization Advance: Mobilization Advance @ 15% of the contract value will be admissible under this contract, on receipt of the same from the client, i.e. UP Jal Nigam. Mobilization Advance @ 10% of the contract value (contract between BBUNL and the successful bidder) will be released on request after awarding of the contract, upon receipt of the Bank Guarantee from a Nationalized Bank for 10% of the contract value (as per contract between BBUNL and UP Jal Nigam) for submission to UP Jal Nigam on behalf of BBUNL and upon receipt of the relevant contractual amount from UP Jal Nigam. Remaining 5% of the contract value (contract between BBUNL and the successful bidder) will be released after receiving the vouchers of the required material and Bank Guarantee of 5% of the contract value (as per contract between BBUNL and UP Jal Nigam) for submission to UP Jal Nigam on behalf of BBUNL.

5.0 The amount of security (including the earnest money) to be deposited by the successful bidder on behalf of BBUNL for the due performance of all the conditions of the contract, shall be sum equal to 10% of the cost of whole work (as per the contract between BBUNL & UP Jal Nigam) which will be deposited in a single stroke in the shape of Bank Guarantee issued by a Nationalized Bank in favour of Project Manager, Ganga Pollution Control Unit, UP Jal Nigam, Allahabad within 10 (ten) days of being called upon to do so after the acceptance of the tender. The Bank Guarantee shall be valid for the full contract period plus maintenance period.

The Security Deposit will be refunded only after satisfactory completion of the work and after expiry of maintenance period of 12 (twelve) months.

6.0 In case of Liquidated Damages (LD) or any other penal measure/compensations are exercised by UP Jal Nigam as per the provision of the contract/tender conditions, the same shall be applicable only on vendors/contractor's portion of work/value with BBUNL's portion of work/value remain unaffected.

7.0 Offer shall be submitted strictly as per the procedure mentioned in Annexure-1 enclosed.

PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF SEALED TENDERS AND DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO BE ENCLOSED WITH THE BID

- 1.0** The tenderer must submit their bids as required in two parts in separate sealed covers prominently superscribed as Part-I, Techno-Commercial Bid, Part-II, price bid and also indicating on each of the covers the tender number, due date and time as mentioned in the tender enquiry.

These two separate covers I and II (Part – I and Part-II) shall together be enclosed in third envelope (Cover-III) and this sealed cover shall also be superscribed with tender no., due date & time and submitted.

2.0 PART-I (TECHNO-COMMERCIAL BID) COVER-I:

The following documents shall be kept in techno-commercial bid envelope:

- 1) Your covering letter towards submission of the bid.
- 2) Bank Guarantee or Demand Draft of Rs. 10.00 Lakh drawn in favour of Bharat Bhari Udyog Nigam Ltd. payable at Kolkata towards Earnest Money Deposit for the amount specified for each tender and as mentioned at Para 1.0 of Notice Inviting Tender.
- 3) Complete set of tender documents (comprising of NIT, Annexure-1, Volume-I & II) including drawings duly signed and stamped on each page as a token of your acceptance of the tender conditions of the subsequent tender of UP Jal Nigam vide no. 417/610/077 dated 11.02.2010 including those as appearing in the Notice Inviting Tender in toto.
- 4) Tenderer's undertaking to accept all contractual terms & condition as appearing in the notice inviting tender, Volume-I & II of the UP Jal Nigam's tender no. 417/610/077 dated 11.02.2010 and also in Annexure-1, both techno-commercial and financial.
- 5) Documentary evidence related to credentials for the bidder to establish that they fulfill the Qualifying Requirement (QR) of preparation of DPR for tender submission.

3.0 PART-II (FINANCIAL BID) COVER – II:

In price bid, sealed price bids quoting the price for the specific scope of work as per Volume-III, duly signed & sealed. In case there is any change in the price bid format, bidder should submit the same duly filled in. Bidder shall submit the price bid considering all the terms & conditions of the UP Jal Nigam's new tender no. 417/610/077 dated 11.02.2010.

4.0 IMPORTANT NOTE

Following documents in addition to the above mentioned at Para – 2 above shall be submitted in techno – commercial bid;

- 1) Solvency certificate for current Year from a Scheduled Bank.
- 2) PAN & Copy of IT returns as filed with IT authority.
- 3) Certificate towards registration with Sales Tax/VAT/Service Tax authorities, as applicable.
- 4) Valid license regarding engagement of workers in the contract works from Labour Department, Govt. of Bihar, if applicable.
- 5) List & Details of similar works executed and under execution.
- 6) List of available Technical Manpower
- 7) Audited Balance sheets for last three years.
- 8) List of Plants & Machineries.

Offers without the above documents are liable to be rejected as "Techno Commercially Non Complying Offers"
